



Ant Treatment & Service Guide



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Before We Arrive (Very Important)

- Do NOT kill or spray the ants
- Leave them alone so we can follow their trail to the nest
- Clear counters and under-sink cabinets
- Put food away and wipe up crumbs
- Give us access to the kitchen and problem areas
- Keep pets and kids away during the service

Leaving the ants alive helps us find the colony and treat it properly.

What You Get Today

- **Initial Treatment** – Targets visible trails and nests inside/outside
 - **Follow-up** – 1 week after initial service
 - **Barrier Application** – Protective line to stop ants from re-entering
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Why Ongoing Service Matters

Ants live in large colonies with multiple queens. What you see are only the workers.

Hidden larvae, pupae, and queens keep producing more ants.

A single treatment reduces the problem, but regular service (monthly or bi-monthly) breaks the colony cycle and prevents re-infestation.

What You Can Do at Home

- Wipe spills and store food in sealed containers
 - Remove pet food overnight
 - Empty trash daily
 - Seal cracks around doors and windows
