

BED BUGS BEWARE!

The Sheriff's undercover prep guide for your hideout



Initial Treatment

- Move furniture away from the walls to allow treatment by pest technicians.
- Move the mattress away from the bed frame to provide access to cracks and crevices for treatment.
- Vacuum or sweep floors and furniture to access cracks and crevices, and immediately dispose of vacuum bags to prevent bed bugs from escaping.
- Remove bed sheets and covers, wash them, and dry them on high heat to kill bed bugs and eggs.
- Clean and sanitize daily after the first treatment.
- Remove unnecessary items to allow better access.
- Follow the technician's directions as closely as possible to ensure rapid success.
- If you have questions, don't hesitate to call before or after treatment.

Follow-up Treatment

- Follow-up treatment 7–10 days after.
- Keep following directions and do not mop areas treated.
- Vacuum or sweep areas treated only.
